Language

Students will be able to:

- Speak in a clear, audible voice.
- Follow prescribed rules for class discussions and listening.
- Participate in choral speaking activities such as chants and rhymes.
- Make predictions about text while it is read.

Composition

Students will be able to:

- Scribble, copy, or write for a purpose.
- Use transitional spelling to write words.
- Sequence pictures, words, or symbols to represent events in a story.
- Practice forming both lower- and uppercase manuscript letters.
- Demonstrate ability to compose in the following areas:
 - Personal experience using first person point of view.
 - Short story.
 - Simple poems.
 - Letter.
 - Class product/project.

Literature

Students will be able to:

- Connect written word and personal experience.
- Participate in choral reading.
- Retell a familiar story including important details related to character and events.
- Recognize his/her name in print.
- Use context to predict next word or event.
- Associate sounds with letters.

Media

Students will be able to:

- Identify a variety of media devices.
- Describe orally a favorite object, photograph, or person.
