

School Year Reminders:

- Send in all updated physicals and immunizations records. *Updates are required for entering Kindergarten and 4th graders*
- Send in medication orders, health care plans, allergy actions plans along with the prescription medication needed for school. *Physician order and parental consent MUST be received before medication can be given at school.*
- Medications must be transported by an adult—STUDENTS SHOULD NOT TRANSPORT MEDICATIONS TO SCHOOL
- Return your confidential emergency card—MAKE SURE YOUR CONTACT INFORMATION IS CURRENT
- Health screens will take place in October or November. If given a referral for your child, please return the completed form to the school nurse as soon as you take your child for further evaluation by a physician
- Please call the nurse line 508-829-6536 if your child will be absent or tardy.
- Please notify the school nurse if your child has a fever of 100 or higher, has strep infection, fifth disease, pneumonia, flu, conjunctivitis, or any other infection where your child is taking antibiotics or medication. This will allow the nurse to alert classrooms with high numbers of certain illnesses.
- Please send your child to school with a water bottle even in the cold months. Many children get constipated throughout the year and drinking plenty of water can alleviate this and avoid missed classtime due to stomach aches.
- Kindergarten registration will take place in March and April
Please send in the following items:
 1. current physical exam
 2. complete immunization record
 3. lead level and date
 4. vision screen from primary physician
 5. copy of child's birth certificate
 6. health history form
