Let me take this opportunity to welcome you to the 2011-2012 school year here at Glenwood Elementary School. I hope everyone is rested and ready to begin what we hope is a memorable school year filled with lots of learning and fun.

The first day of school for the 2011-2012 school year will be a full day on Tuesday, August 30, 2011. Our start times and end times remain the same at 9:10 am and 3:40 pm. Van students are dismissed at 3:25 pm, car riders, walkers, Club House students, and bus students are dismissed at 3:30 pm.

Car riders are dropped off and picked up in the **rear** of the school. All bus and van students are dropped off and picked up in **front** of the school.

On early dismissal days, students are dismissed at 12:40 pm with no lunch served and no recess.
