ONLINE REGISTRATION NOW OPEN!

Registration for this year's after-school Ski and Snowboarding program sponsored by Wachusett Mt. is now open online. This year's program will begin on Monday January 7, 2019 and will run for six weekly sessions through the end of February depending on weather and snow conditions. When registering, sign up for 6 week program lift badge or a seasons pass. If a student already has a season pass and is registering for transportation only, please see below. **DO NOT REGISTER FOR THE 8 WEEK PROGRAM.** There is no program scheduled for either the Martin Luther King holiday or during the February vacation. There will not be any program on days that school is cancelled or dismissed early. Any sessions missed due to school cancellation or weather will be made up at the end of the season.

The program is open to all Mountview students on a first come - first served basis. and has limited space. Last year the program filled with over 100 students within a few days of the opening of registration, so please do not delay completing the online registration by following the directions below. Registration will automatically end once the maximum number of students is reached. Students not making the initial group can be placed on a waiting list by emailing the Program Coordinator. Additional buses will only be added if there are enough students to meet the minimum requirements.

TO REGISTER go to WWW.WACHUSETT.COM/SCHOOLGROUP and enter the code **MOUN** to access the registration form. (Do not attempt to access this registration site through the Mountain's Webpage. There are no links from the regular webpage to the school registration site.) Once you have entered the registration site, select the services needed and fill in the student information portion of the registration. If you have already purchased a season pass and simply want to sign up for the bus, you **MUST** check the "already have season pass" option on the registration form. All registrants must pay the transportation fee noted on the registration form. Registration will remain open through the end of November or until we have reached maximum capacity. All questions should be directed to the Program Coordinator either by phone or email. The school or the mountain will only redirect your calls.

It is very important that your email address listed on the registration form is accurate and one that is monitored regularly. Most communications regarding the program will be done through either email or announcements at the school. Once your student is registered, information will be emailed (to the email address listed on the registration form) regarding equipment drop off, transportation schedules, etc. If there are additional email addresses to which you would like notices sent, please let me know. Upon completing the registration process, please email me at the email address below so that we can double check the mountain's enrollment list.

CHAPERONES

The program depends on volunteers and we are always looking for chaperones to assist with the program. Chaperones ski free on program days and get complimentary rental equipment if needed. Chaperones who volunteer for at least 3 sessions also get a weekend pass good for both Saturday and Sunday later in the season. You do not have to commit for all six weeks, but we do ask that you are available to chaperone with the transportation portion of the program. WHO'S ELIGIBLE

Students 8yrs & older, teachers & parents of those students.
Family members only eligible if participating in Recreation Department and YMCA programs.

HOW TO SIGN UP

- Contact your program coordinator for your program details, bus fee and the Access Code. Bus fees paid to the coordinator must be completed to receive the Access Code. (If Wachusett supplies your bus, sign up with your coordinator first to receive the code.)
- Go to: wachusett.com/schoolgroups and enter Access Code.
- For best price order by Dec 5th (some schools may have earlier deadlines)

START DATE

The **Six** and **Eight** week sessions starts **Wednesday, January 2, 2019**.
(No program Jan. 21, 2019 or Feb. 18-22, 2019).

EQUIPMENT

- **Renting**—Rental Packages (include skis/poles/boots or snowboard/boots and helmets) are available for your program days OR full season. *Rental equipment for use at Wachusett only.*
- **Bringing your own**—Equipment should be marked with NAME, SCHOOL, AND PHONE NUMBER.

LESSONS

- Lessons for beginners and novice (Levels 1-4), are required. (See Class Level description when ordering the lesson online.)
- Intermediate to advanced lessons are also available and recommended.

GETTING THERE

- The coordinator arranges transportation to the mountain. Most school programs include transportation fees. Bus Fees are required to be in the program (**whether you ride the bus or not.**)
- Additional transportation fee may be required if low enrollment.

MORE FOR YOUR MONEY

- **\$5 COW Card Bonus** -- Purchase a \$50 gift card for only \$45. Card is valid for food, MTNside Ski & Ride Shop and more. If lost, there is a \$5 replacement fee – we will replace remaining value on a new card.
- Starting March 1st, receive 50% off lift tickets, lessons, and rentals with your Student Badge or Season Pass. (One time per session) *Cannot be combined with other credits or discounts.*
- Use your Season Pass for discounts at other participating ski areas. Passholder benefits and specials also offered at MTNside Ski & Ride Shop and other area locations. Go to wachusett.com/passholderperks for details.

BADGE/PASS INSURANCE

Provides Student Badge/Season Pass Replacement at a pro-rated refund if unable to use services due to unforeseen circumstances.
Must be purchased when badge/pass is ordered.
