

POLICY RELATING TO SUPPORT OPERATIONS

SECURITY OF THE SCHOOL FACILITY

The Wachusett Regional School community buildings and grounds are one of the greatest investments of the District. It is deemed in the best interest of the District to protect the investment adequately.

The Superintendent of Schools will ensure that the District and Town assets are secured, maintained, and protected adequately from fire hazards and faulty equipment, and staff will be trained in safe practices in the use of electrical, plumbing, and heating equipment. The Superintendent of Schools (or designee) is to provide close cooperation with fire and law enforcement departments and with insurance company inspectors.

Access to school buildings and grounds outside of regular school hours and/or permitted-uses will be limited to personnel whose work requires it. Adequate access-control systems will be established, which will safeguard against the chance of entrance to buildings by unauthorized persons.

Provisions shall be made to store funds and valuable records in a safe place and under lock and key.

The District shall secure buildings, assure fire protection, and maintain security equipment.
